



# Wynns Coonawarra Estate



## Harold Vineyard Limited Release Cabernet Sauvignon 2001

Wynns Coonawarra Estate was the first winery to be built in the Coonawarra, by John Riddoch in 1896. The winery is located on the world famous strip of 'Terra Rossa' soil that produces fruit of an exceptionally high quality, particularly Cabernet Sauvignon.

Established in 1971, the Wynns Harold Vineyard is a dry grown, 9-hectare block, set in the heart of some of the best Terra Rossa soils in Coonawarra. Planted entirely to Cabernet Sauvignon, the Harold Vineyard produced such an exceptional crop in 2001 it was decided to release the first bottling of this unique, single vineyard wine.

### Regional Source

The Wynns Harold Vineyard, Coonawarra.

### Vintage Conditions

Good winter rains gave Coonawarra a very good start to the season. Fruit set was excellent, and careful vineyard management including 'green harvesting' to remove heavy crops aided in controlling yields. March rainfall delayed the harvest, but April and May were fine and mild and the fruit was picked in good condition.

### Grape Variety

Cabernet Sauvignon

### Maturation

This wine was matured for 18 months in new French oak.

## Winemaker Comments: Sue Hodder



### Colour

Intense dark red.



### Nose

Aromas of dark cherries are supported by cedary French oak.



### Palate

An opulent and full palate. Flavours of dark mint chocolate combine with hints of sage and softly spiced French oak. Supple tannins support the deep, long finish to produce a densely structured wine that will reward careful cellaring.
