Wynns Coonawarra Estate was the first winery to be established in the Coonawarra, by John Riddoch in 1896. The winery is located on the world famous strip of 'Terra Rossa' soil that produces fruit with intensely concentrated flavours.

Launched in 1952 as Coonawarra Estate Claret, this wine has long upheld Wynns Coonawarra Estate's reputation as a producer of premium Coonawarra shiraz.

Vintage Conditions

A dry, warm winter promoted good bud fruitfulness followed by a spring with limited frost concerns which meant overall vine health was excellent. January was hot and dry, tempered by a cool February that steadied ripening. Warm weather at harvest ensured full flavour development. Harvest was over by 19 April.

Maturation

This wine was matured for six months with new and seasoned French and American oak.

Colour

Young and vibrant with red-purple hues.

Nose

The nose shows some elegant, floral notes, aromas of crushed raspberries with an edge of spice and smoky oak. Rich vanilla and spice aromas support concentrated dark cherry fruit and toasty fragrant oak on the nose.

Palate

Appealing ripe, gentle tannins and soft acidity frame the sweet Shiraz palate. This is an elegant, cool climate styled Shiraz with attractive black fruit flavours. Earthy, spicy notes add complexity and length to this medium bodied gem.
